Stella Griffiths Elected Chair of SC9

- Stella Griffiths was elected Chair of ISO TC 46/SC 9 by unanimous vote of TC 46 and assumed responsibilities on January 1, 2015
- She is Executive Director of the International ISBN Agency, and Convener of the ISBN Revision Working Group

SC 9 Plenary Week in Beijing

- Meeting of ISBN Working Group
- Meeting of ISRC Working Group
- Joint Meeting of Ad Hoc Identifiers Interoperability Group and Ad Hoc Registration Authority Group
- SC 9 Plenary Session, Thursday, June 4
 - 35 Attendees
 - Representing 15 countries

Status of work 1/4

- ISO DIS 17316, Information and documentation — International standard link identifier (ISLI)
 - Published on May 15, 2015
 - International Information Content Industry Association (ICIA) was appointed as the Registration Authority for ISLI
 - ICIA was invited to request Category-A Liaison status with SC 9

Status of work 2/4

- ISO 2108:2005, Information and documentation – International standard book number (ISBN)
 - Committee Draft circulated for ballot, which closed on April 4, 2015
 - Approved (26 Yes, 0 No, 4 Abstentions)
 - In-person meeting on June 3rd, 2015
 - Anticipating next draft by autumn.

Status of work 3/4

- ISO NP 3901 International Standard Recording Code (ISRC)
 - Group meeting twice per month and making progress
 - Expected DIS submission & ballot last summer, but requested an extension
 - New limit date of January 16, 2015.
 - SC 9 instructed the WG to submit a draft for circulation before December 1, by consensus ballot if necessary

- ISO 15707 - *International Standard Work Code* (ISWC)
 - José Macarro (CISAC) appointed as Convener
 - Reinitiating work, needed more experts

Status of work 4/4

- WG12, Indexes and indexing
 - Decision to merge ISO 999 (*Guidelines for the content, organization and presentation of indexes*) and ISO 5963 (*Methods for examining documents, determining their subjects, and selecting indexing terms*)
 - Janet Shuter appointed Convenor
- WG13, International library item identifier(ILII)
 - Proposal by JISC (Japan) to develop a new standard for an International Library Item Identifier (ILII). The proposal was approved by the members in November and assigned the project number 20247.
 - Akira Miyazawa appointed Convenor

Reaffirmed

- ISO 21047:2009, Information and documentation – International Standard Text Code (ISTC)
 - But requested the Registration Authority to forward a New Work Item Proposal by December 31, 2015 to revise the standard to address stakeholder needs regarding work identification.

- ISO 10957:2009 – International Standard Music Number,
 - But instructed the Registration Authority to further review the standard as soon as the ISO 2108 ISBN standard revision text is stable

Reaffirmed

- ISO 4: 1997, Information and documentation -- Rules for the abbreviation of title words and titles of publications

Revision Launched

 None

New Liaison

- Worldwide Independent Network ('WIN') approved as a Category D liaison for SC9/WG10 International Standard Recording Code (ISRC)

Identifier Interoperability

- Continued to consider the work of the Linked Content Coalition draft of “Principles of Identification” work
- Ad hoc members will review document and consider putting the “Principles” forward as an ISO TR

Status of Registration Agencies in ISO Standards

- ISO/TC 46/SC 9 noted the concerns of some members of the ad hoc group on Registration Authorities regarding the status of registration agencies in new and revised ISO standards. SC 9 establishes a further ad hoc group comprised of representatives of affected Registration Authorities to formulate a position and discuss it with ISO CS.
