Membership trends – "The Good"


Significant growth in LSA Membership Result of aggressive marketing and expanded LSA member benefits

Membership trends 1998-2013





Executive Summit

Bibliographic Future Roadmap Grant

- Received \$45,000 grant from Andrew W.
 Mellon Foundation to organize one 2-day meetings and several virtual meetings
- Goal is to build coordination mechanism for those working on bibliographic exchange
 - Identify gaps
 - Outline potential solutions to gaps
- Report due in February 2014



ONIX-PL Project Grant

- Funded by the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation \$44,000
 - Additional support from JISC offered
- Gather and encode publisher template licenses using ONIX-PL
- Post those encodings in an open repository
- Record training materials on using ONIX-PL
- More detail later



Alternative Assessment Initiative

- \$222,000 Grant from the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation
- 2 Phase project to explore issues of standardization of alternative assessment issues


Educational Programs for 2014

ISQ Open Access and Online

- Still moving toward ceasing print publication of ISQ
- Remains freely available to community – open access
- Print copies still available
- Usage
 - 2008 Views 5,000
 - 2009 Views 12,000
 - 2010 Views 15,000
 - 2011 Views 52,000
 - 2012 Views 43,000
 - 2013 Views 58,000
