Subject: ISO New Proposal 20925 on a version identifier for audiovisual works

Attached as document N 335 is an ISO New Project proposal for a version identification scheme for audiovisual works. This version identification scheme is intended to complement the International Standard Audiovisual Number (ISAN) defined in ISO FDIS 15706.

This project was first registered as ISO Preliminary Work Item 20925 in April 2001. A Working Draft for Project 20925 is attached for information. The draft outlines the proposed syntax for a version identifier as a suffix to the ISAN.

The ISO/TC 46/SC 9 Secretariat proposes to assign the development of Project 20925 to Working Group 1 which was responsible for the ISAN standard. The proposed terms of reference for WG 1 for Project 20925 are attached as document N 337.

For the development of Project 20925, some national bodies may wish to adjust their representation on WG 1 to involve additional industry sectors with an interest in version identification (e.g. broadcasters, television listing services, etc.). Accordingly, organizations having either P-member or A-liaison status with ISO/TC 46/SC 9 are invited to nominate new experts to participate in WG 1 or to reconfirm their existing representation.

ACTIONS REQUESTED:

1. P-members are to confirm their approval of and intention to participate in ISO Project 20925 by returning ISO Form 5 for this proposal to the ISO/TC 46/SC 9 Secretariat no later than June 14, 2002.

- 2. P-members are requested to approve the proposed WG 1 terms of reference for Project 20925 shown in N 337 no later than June 14, 2002.
- 3. P-members and A-liaison organizations are requested to nominate new experts or to confirm their existing representation on WG 1 for the development of ISO Project 20925. Nominations should be returned to the ISO/TC 46/SC 9 Secretariat no later than June 14, 2002.

Scope of proposed project			
Project 20925 will specify a scheme for the unique international identification of versions of audiovisual works. As such it will complement the International Standard Audiovisual Number (ISAN) defined in ISO FDIS 15706.			
The version identifier [currently called the V-ISAN] is intended to extend the usefulness of the ISAN for applications that require identification of not only the audiovisual work but also the various versions in which that work is made available.			
ISO 20925 is proposed for development as a two-part standard. Part 1 will cover the format and use of the version identification scheme. Part 2 will address procedures for assignment and registration of the version identifier defined in Part 1.
