





The mission of NISO is to build knowledge, foster discussion, and advance authoritative standards development through collaboration among the cultural, scholarly, scientific, and professional communities.








NISO MEMBERSHIP 1998-2022



NISO REVENUES 1998-2021 (Pre-Audit)




NISO EXPENSES 1998-2021 (Pre-Audit)


